New Art in Parking Places Exhibit at Maritime Garage Gallery *Industrial Evolution - Opens June 13*

Norwalk, CT (May 31, 2013) - - The Norwalk Parking Authority's Art in Parking Places presents "Industrial Evolution" at the Maritime Garage Gallery, running from June 13 through September 6. The Gallery will hold an **opening reception on June 13th from 5:00-7:00pm at the Gallery, 11 North Water Street.**

"Industrial Evolution" features selected artwork in all media that depict inspirational urban and technological elements of evolution over the past 150 years, weaving images from an age of emerging invention and development with the modern day. Among the exhibiting artists are Ingrid Conklin (Fairfield), Hu Lindsay (Norwalk), Ruth Kalla Ungerer (Ridgefield), and Steve Pomerantz (Ridgefield), Lisa Wilson Grant (Rowayton), Katya Lebrija and Rebecca Kudwitt (both from Westport).

Curator Sooo-z Mastropietro describes the artwork this way, "The art creates a bit of a time travel experience, revealing some inventions that flourish as improvements that we cannot live without on a daily basis, others loom as evidence emphasizing an era gone by."
