Good Things in Small Packages At The Maritime Garage Gallery

Norwalk, CT (July 2, 2019) - - Works of art that are small in size, but big on creativity are on exhibit this summer at the Maritime Garage Gallery. “Small Treasures” features works of art that are no larger than 12 by 12 inches. The exhibit runs from July 15 - October 5, 2019 with an opening reception July 17th from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m.

“The small-scale pieces vary in media and style, and each one represents a moment in time that could have been captured in real life or the imagination,” says curator Nadia Martinez. “They are things, ideas, places or moments that we hold as treasures and spark an emotion within us.”
